## Briefing Sheet for Dinghy Do...

- **Harbour regulations and speed limits should be adhered to at all times**

**Please ensure your dinghy and engine are in serviceable condition**

**You will need an engine to get through the locks and oars in case of engine failure**

### **Additionally .....please**

- Wear appropriate clothing and footwear for the day including a lifejacket for all participants
- Brief your crew on your plan of action
- The Driver should wear the 'Kill Cord' (if fitted) when the engine is running and the dinghy is underway
- **Avoid the mud, so act in good time!!**

**The dinghy skipper is responsible for the health and safety of their crew, the maximum dinghy loading and adherence to the Collision regulations**
